The reconvene of the regular October Meeting of Borough Council was conducted on Wednesday, October 25, 2006 at 7:00 P.M. The Meeting was held in Borough Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, 304 South State Street, Borough of Clarks Summit, County of Lackawanna, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Council members in attendance were Council President Donald H. Moyer, III, Council Vice President Margaret (Peg) Jackson, Councilperson Gerry Carey, Councilman Roy Davis, Councilman Ray Taylor, and Councilman Patrick Williams. Motion made by Mrs. Jackson, seconded by Mr. Davis to accept the agenda as presented. Discussion: None. Motion carried 6-0.

ELECTION OF COUNCIL MEMBER:

Motion made by Mrs. Jackson, seconded by Mr. Moyer to nominate James Colman to fill the vacancy due to Dick Armbrust's resignation. Discussion: Mr. Gallagher, a Borough resident, asked for information on Mr. Colman's credentials. Mr. Colman replied that he was a 40-year resident of the community and lives on Sleepy Hollow Road. He is self-employed at Colman Sales, 1033 Morgan Highway. His wife is an unemployed RN and he has two daughters. He also stated that his father was on Council many years ago. Motion carried 6 -0.
